

SECTION 4(f)

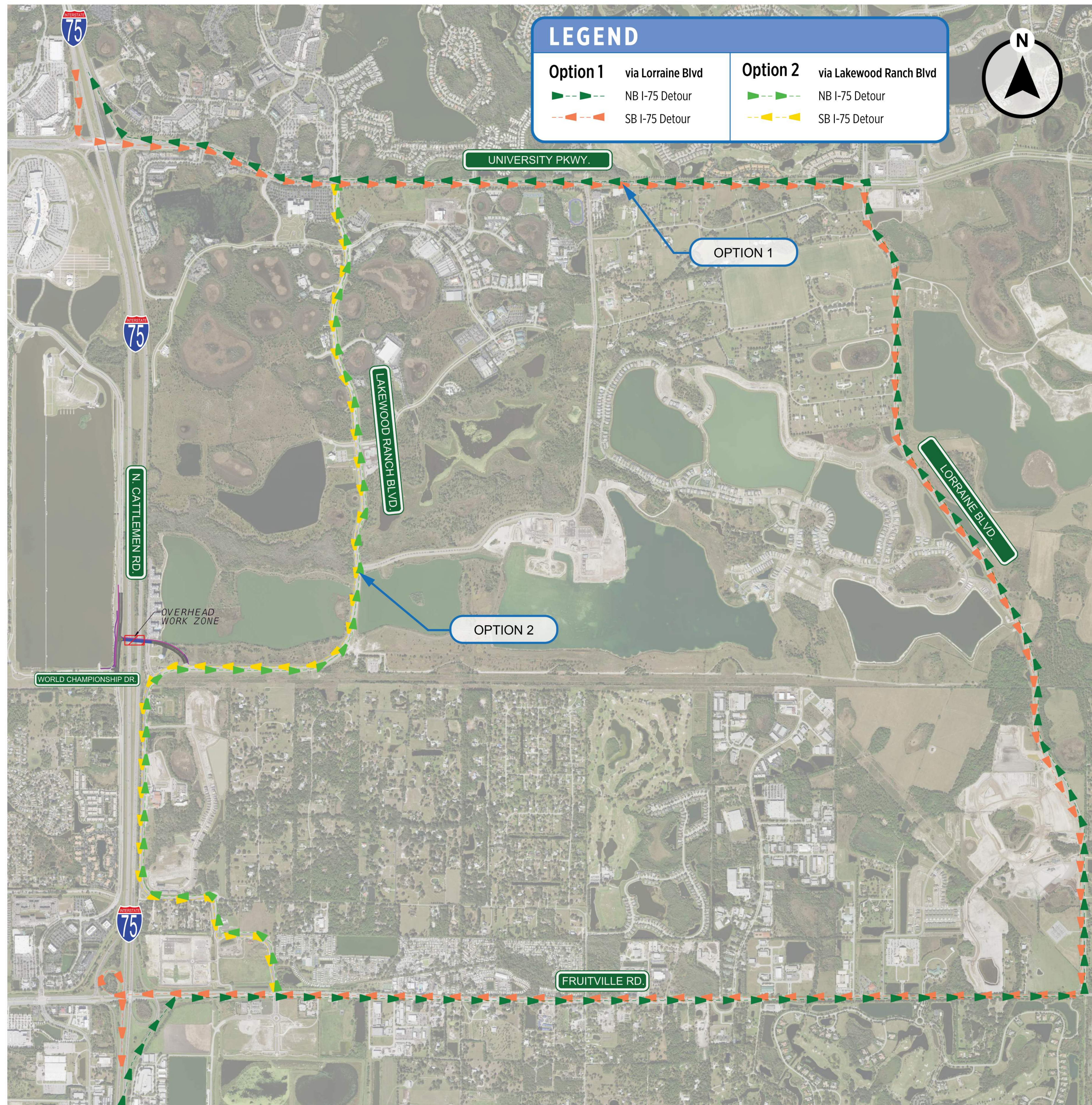

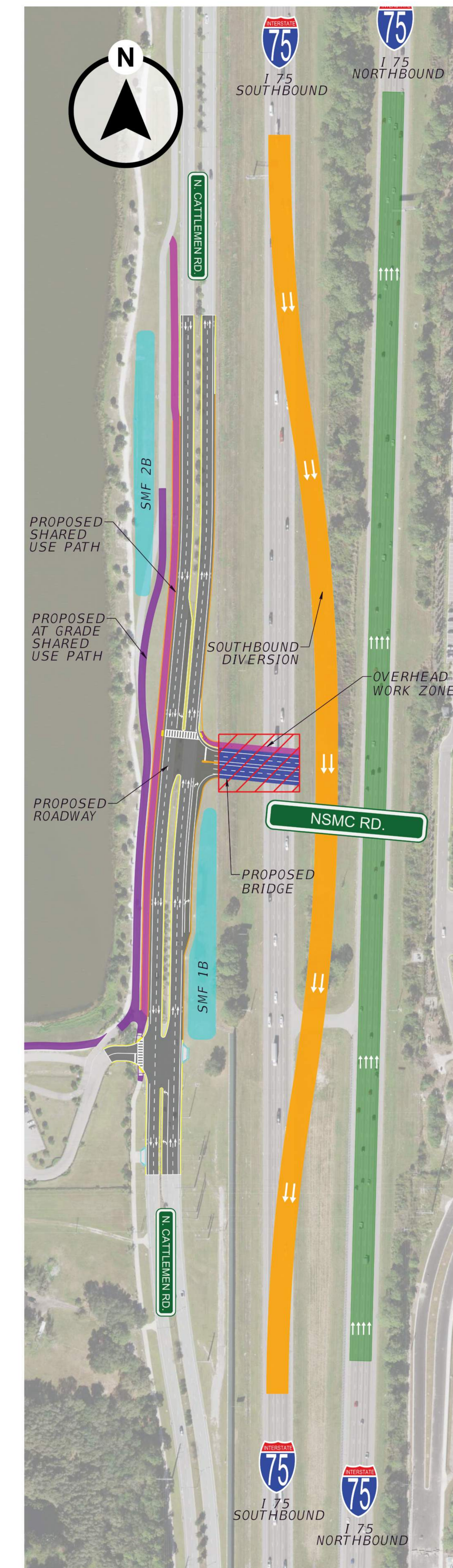
Design Options for I-75 Maintenance of Traffic During Overhead Bridge Construction

CONCEPT 1 - Nightly Lane Closure

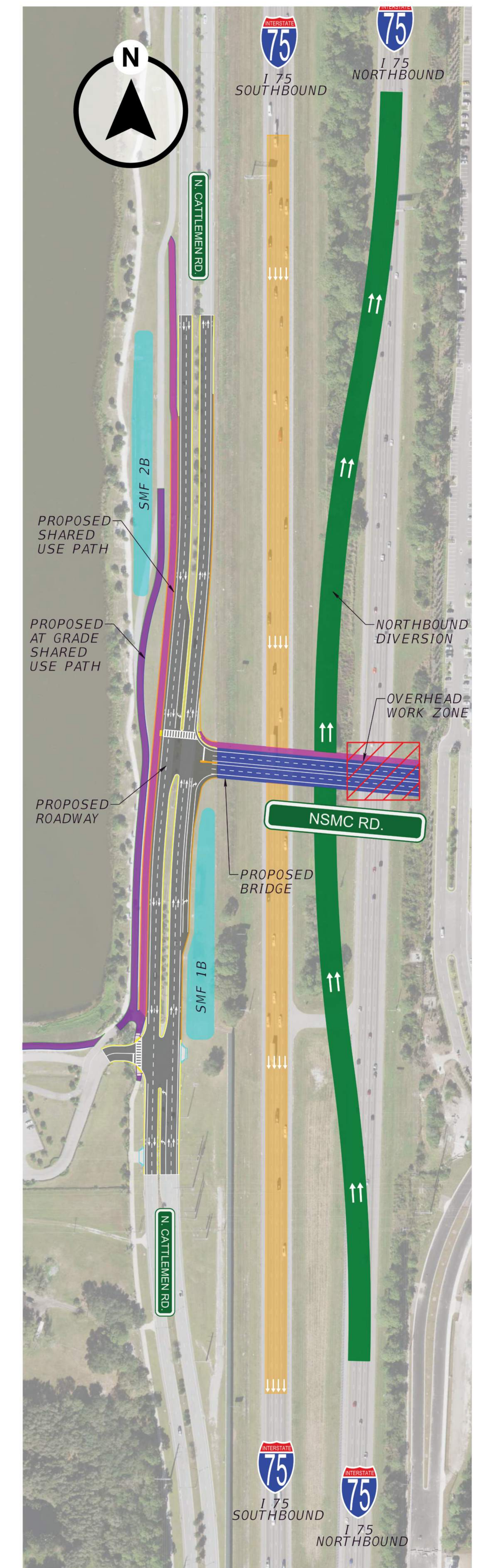


Detour during Overpass Construction
